**907 This meeting was called for the Council to consider a resolution to move the Parish Council bank account from Nat West to the Coop bank, (subject to the terms of the Business Banking Switch package) and the mechanism for doing so.**

The background to this meeting was given by Cllr Robinson. The movement of the bank account had been considered with the previous Clerk but it had been felt preferable to wait until a new Clerk was appointed. The offer from Nat West had come about due to the previous assistance from the Government who required increased competition between banks.

The Coop bank was the only offer available with the Switch package. The Council agreed that the **Clerk** go ahead to make the application to switch to the Coop Bank provided the Parish Council could get the offer. If not then the Council would review the banking arrangements. It was agreed that the main aim at present is for the Council to have free internet banking.

At the next meeting a resolution authorising the new account use and operation must be passed.
