The Litchborough Parochial Charity has been active in the parish since the late 1870s, and is funded by two other charities. Its aims are to offer financial assistance to those in need, specifically the elderly, widows, widowers, students and apprentices, and those in ill health or distress.

Heating grants

These are granted to retired persons living in the parish who are in need of assistance with heating costs, through direct payments to energy suppliers, normally in December each year. Existing beneficiaries do not need to reapply.

Education and training grants

If you are at college or university, on an apprenticeship or vocational training course, the charity may be able to award a grant towards the cost of items you have to buy, such as equipment or books. The grant would be for the academic year and may be drawn on throughout that year, supported by evidence of expenditure. Students may apply each year until they have completed their studies.

Other requests for assistance

If you are experiencing financial hardship through ill health or other difficulty, the charity may be able to help with grants towards costs, for example transport to and from hospital.
